A draft Action Plan was placed before the Resource Management Committee during a recent meeting and was adopted. A copy of the Action Plan was attached to the report.

The Workshop that was proposed for July 2007, was deferred until August 2007, due to the absence of a number of Councillors in July. It was scheduled to be held at 1 pm on 24 August. which would be attended by Councillors and appropriate staff.

In particular the government was looking to establish contemporary views on “key principles to guide policing”, how legislation can support effective policing for all New Zealanders, promote the employment of the right kind of people into the NZ Police Service, and set down platforms for the success of the NZ Police Service.

More information was available in the Executive Summary of the review document.

Milford Sound Development Authority Limited for land use consent to disturb land  
and vegetation adjacent to the foreshore during the demolition of the existing Milford  
Sound breakwater and construction of a new breakwater at Freshwater Basin and to  
disturb land and vegetation along the true right bank of the Cledeau River to provide  
for machinery access across the true right bank of the Cledeau River, was to be heard
