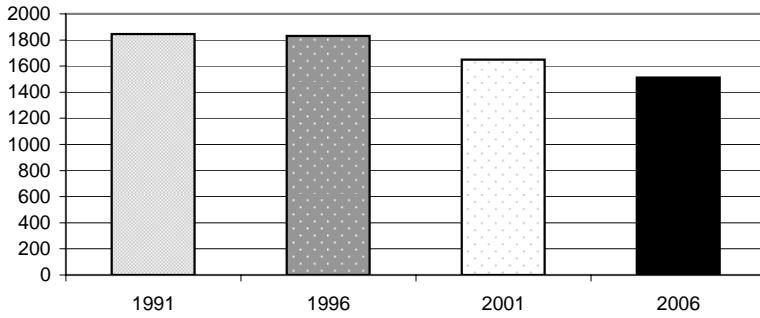

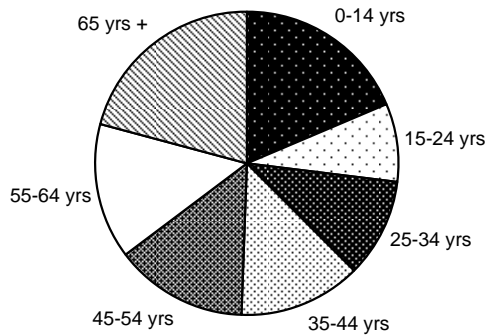
## Usually Resident Population

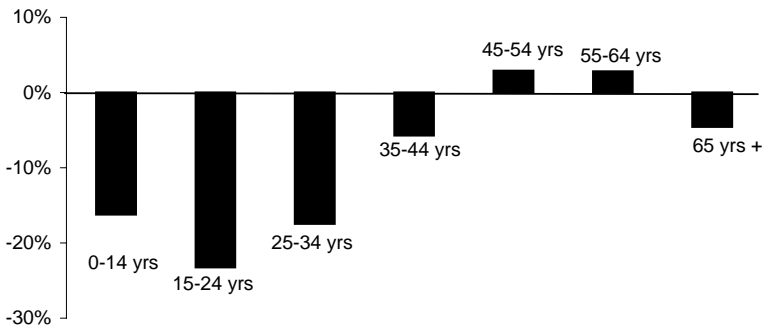

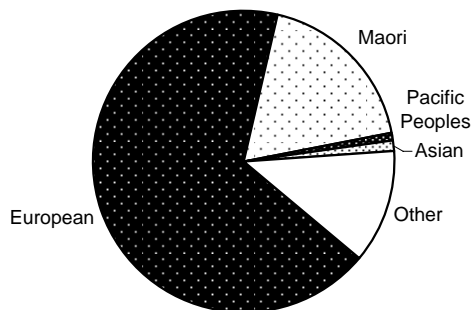

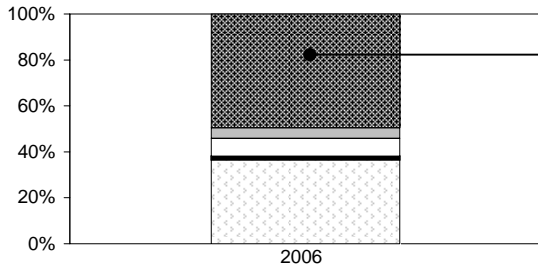

## Employment Status: 15 Years and Over



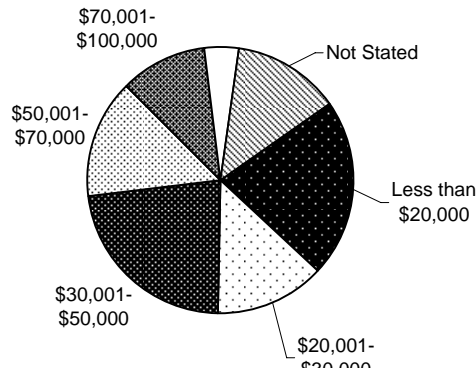

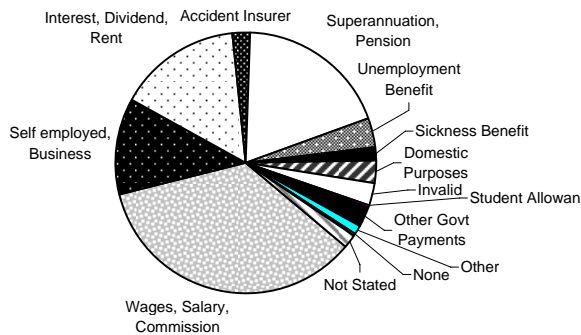
