1.0 Introduction

The Milford Community Trust was established in 2007 by the Southland District Council and the Department of Conservation, with the assistance of Environment Southland for the purpose of providing leadership and governance in Milford Sound *Piopiotahi*.

In terms of the Local Government Act, the Trust is defined as a Council Controlled Organisation reporting the Southland District Council. The Trust was incorporated under the Charitable Trusts Act 1957 on 18 May 2007. The Charities Commission has approved the Trust as being exempt for taxation purposes.

This report covers the six monthly period from 1 July 2015 to 31 December 2015.

2.0 Chairman's Six Monthly Report: (Chairman - Mike Schuck)

This report covers the six months from 1 July 2015 to 31 December 2015.

On behalf of the Milford Community Trust (MCT) I would like to welcome new Trustees Jason Steele and Rosco Gaudin. I was pleased with the level of interest from the community for the vacant trustee positions and am looking forward to the ideas and contributions these new Trustees will bring to the Trust.

I thank departing Trustees Natalie Shanks and Jane Grant for their service to the Milford Sound community during their time as Trustees.

A major concern for the community is the establishment of a community centre. This became more urgent following the closure of the Milford Sound Hotel leaving the community without a venue for local events and community activities. The MCT has listened to these concerns and will be seeking feedback from concessionaires and locals for how a new centre should be funded and the design features for the new centre. The MCT had included the construction of a new centre as a planned activity in the Trust's Statement of Intent.

The Team Leader Emergency Services contract has been renewed and the new Team Leader is Jayne Pearson who is from the Bay of Plenty, and is a qualified ILS paramedic. Jayne has had relevant experience in England and Fox Glacier.

We continue to work on advancing the building of the Cleddau Village Green, the redevelopment of Deepwater Basin and the re-opening of the access to the Bowen Falls.

The Trustees intend carrying out a review of the Milford Community Trust Deed during 2016. This review will consider the functions and responsibilities of the Trust including a review of the charging mechanism for concession fees.

3.0 Meetings

There were two meetings of the Trust held during this six month period.
