Southland District Council has engaged in the services of Fulton Hogan to undertake a Storm Water renewal project within the Clyde Street/ Eglington Drive area of Winton, this is to repair aged pipelines.

The project includes excavating trench lines within the road boundary of Clyde Street and Eglington Road. The works will be split into stages to allow site works to be contained within areas and manage traffic, residents and pedestrian movements with the least disturbance required.

Due to the nature of this type of work, streets above will be open to residents only during the project to safely provide a working area for our staff and the general public. Staff onsite will ensure the safe entry and exit to your property at all times.
